


GOD'S SIMPLE PLAN OF SALVATION FROM JOÃO



Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

João 3:19 A'tíro niî'. Jesu Cristo sî'oo'se weeró noho niîmi. Kîñ Õ'âkîhi yeere ȿ'yógi a'tîwî. Kîñ a'tiká, a'ti nukúkâkâharâ kîñre iatikârâ niîwâ. Kîñre iaró noho o'ôrâ, yã'âro weesé pe'ere iâri peha yuurâ, na'lî tî'aropî niirâ weeró noho niîkârâ niîwâ.



We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

João 3:18 Õ'âkîhi kîñ makiré ȿ'ho peórâre bu'îri da'rêsome. Kîñ makí ni'kí niigíre ȿ'ho peótikâ pûrikâre, bu'îri da'rêgisami.

João 3:36 Kîñ makiré ȿ'ho peórâ noho katî nu'kusere kiomá. Kîñre ȿ'ho peó sî'ritirâ pe'e Õ'âkîhi tiropî wa'âsome. Õ'âkîhire ipiti bu'îri da'rê no'orâsama.



There is a cost for your sin!

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

João 14:6 Jesu kñre niwñ: —Yi'ñ, yi'ñ pakí tiropí wa'arí ma'a weeró noho niñ'. Yi'ñ masaré toopí wa'aká weegí niñ'. Yi'ñ masaré diakñhíkñhasere masiká' weé'. Naâre katí nu'kuká weegí niñ'. Yi'ñre ñho peórã dí'akí yi'ñ pakí tiropí wa'ârásama.

João 6:40 Yi'ñre o'ôo'ki a'tíro weeká' iamí. “Niî pe'tirã yi'ñre ñho peórã katí nu'kuká'râsama”, niîmi. Yi'ñ a'ti ñmíkoho pe'tiká', naâre masogísa', niwñ Jesu.

João 3:17 Õ'âkñhi a'ti nukúkâharâre bu'íri da'régiti niigí meheta kñ makiré o'ôo'ki niwñ. Naâre yi'riogí pe'e tohô weéki niwñ.

João 1:10,12 Maatápita Õ'âkñhi kñ me'ra a'tí di'tare weéki niwñ. Kñ a'topí niiká', kñ weéka di'takâharâ niñmirâ, kñre ñ'yâ masitikârâ niwñ. Ni'karérâ kñre yê'ê ñho peówâ. Niî pe'tirã kñre ñho peórâre Õ'âkñhi pô'ra sâhakâ weewí.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Atos 4:12 A'ti nukúkâpíre Jesu Cristo di'akí niîmi maríre yi'riogí. Ñpérâpia maríre neê yi'rió masitisama, niîki niwñ Pedro.

Efésios 2:8-9 A'tíro niñ'. Marí Jesu Cristore ñho peórã Õ'âkñhi ñyuró weesé me'ra yi'riowí. Teé marí basi weé'ke meheta niñ'. Õ'âkñhi pe'e maríre yi'riowí. Marí ñyuró weesére ñ'yâgí meheta yi'riowí. Tohô weégí neê ni'kí “Yi'ñ ñyuró weé'ke wapa Õ'âkñhi yi'ñre yi'riowí”, niîta basió wee'.


Tito 3:5 Marí tohô weesétimiká, Õ'âkñhi kñ ñyuró weesére, kñ ma'isére ñ'yogí maríre yi'riowí. Marí ñyuró weesére ñ'yâgí meheta yi'riowí. Kñ pahá yâ'agi, maríre yi'riowí. Opâturi maríre wi'marâ neê bahuárâre weeró noho weewí. Kñ wêrisé me'ra marí yâ'aro weé'kere kô'âgi yi'riowí. Espírito Santo maríre ñyurâ' wa'â dutigí díka yuúwí.

5. You must believe on the Lord and you will have everlasting life!

João 5:24 Diakîhíta misâre niîgiti. Yi'î niisére ti'orá, yi'îre o'ôo'kire ēho peórã katî nu'kusere kiomá. Naâ bu'íri da'rê no'osome. Naâ pekâ me'epi wa'â boo'kârã yi'ri wetí tohama.

João 6:47 Diakîhíta misâre niîgiti. Yi'îre ēho peógi katî nu'kugisami.

João 10:28 Naâre katî nu'kusere o'ô'. Naâ pekâ me'epi wa'âsome. Yi'î naâre ko'tê nu'kukîti. Neê ni'kí, yarâré yi'îre e'mâ masisome.



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.
